<u>Our Hearts in God's Heart</u>

On Easter Sunday, we remembered together that in our dying and in our living, our hearts rest in the heart of God. When I look at myself and other people, I am invited to see with the eyes of Christ, so that I only see hearts, only love, only spirit. It's like the picture at the top of this message: God's big heart holding all our hearts together. No matter what I think or do or feel—no matter what anyone thinks or does or feels—I and everyone are held in the heart of God forever. This reality can never be taken away, can never change.

Our dear sister Carol Schweickhardt, had a massive brain trauma event last Friday in her home and died at Regions Hospital yesterday, Tuesday Apr 11. Carol who never thought of herself as a singer but absolutely loved being in choir. Carol who saw all of life as a possible art project. Carol who said that Edgcumbe Church was the one place where she knew with no doubts that she was loved. Carol's body stopped working on Tuesday. Carol's heart rests in the heart of God. It always did; it always will.

We are gathering **this evening at 7pm** to be together after Carol's death on Tuesday. We don't know anything yet about the family's or our own plans for a memorial service. This will be a casual get-together in the chair circle in the backwoods, like an old-fashioned wake. The point is simply to be together for comfort and stories and peace. All are welcome.
