advent: the season of the heart

advent is a season in the liturgical calendar (liturgical means pertaining to happy advent!! worship-the church year). in latin, ad- means "to" + venire means, "come". it is a season preparing us for that which is coming which is the birth of god-with-us, immanuel. christmas is the time when we mark the extension of god's love among us in human form. and the thing is, *love* is being born amongst us-it is not a *mental* event. it is love-among-us, which means it is our hearts that will receive (or not receive) the gift that is coming. which is why this year, more than ever, i sense an invitation for us to tend to our hearts during these days of advent, so that we can truly **accept**, **allow** and **receive** the christ child. we don't just want to know about god's love, we want to **experience** it, be **transformed** by it, and **rest** in it. which means that advent allows us to look with the holy spirit to see what, if any, kind of barriers or walls we have erected around our hearts. it is such a human impulse to guard and hide our hearts, but our hearts are where the real interchange and exchange happens with god/absolute love. so, we join holy spirit and ask to see what are our defenses and blocks to love...we need to see what they are so that we can bring these parts of ourselves to the holy spirit's light for her repurposing and healing!!

dear ones, it is advent and it is our opportunity to intentionally check in with our hearts. so-right now, i invite you to pause, to come into presence with your breath, and bring your attention to your heart space. what do you notice?? are you willing to invite holy spirit into your heart space?? are you willing to encounter each moment fully with your heart open?? this is our advent practice, so that when christmas comes, the portals of our hearts are flung open wide!! *holy spirit, in this holy moment, you be in charge, and we will follow you, trusting that your direction will lead us to peace!!* A deep thank you to all who were able to decorate the sanctuary this past weekend!! The worship space is gorgeous and has become such an integral part of our Advent and Christmas journey!! Thank you to Meredith and Kathy for providing leadership to us!!

December's mission is Project Home, a program of Interfaith Action of St. Paul.
