Retreat Reflection

Hello Edgecumbe Family,

I wanted to reflect about Retreat. It seems to be the Year of Retreat for me. I went on a 10 day silent retreat in Albuquerque in April. I went on a 5 day silent retreat in May at a Zen Retreat Center (Hokyogi) and I am leaving in a few days to do a darkness retreat in a cave in the mountains of Oregon.

Why? Why am I doing this? Something is calling for sure. I believe that God desires us to fully let go of our stories of disconnection- Maybe I go on retreat so I am able to be quiet enough to fully take that in.

In New Mexico, the intention and invitation was to soften and receive. I had moments of deep pain and moments of transcendent love and I just sat in meditation and felt it all.

At Hokyogi, I seemed to be guided into new understandings of how much I am loved and also how much I hide and project my shadow onto others. I also reconnected with my silly goofy inner child! Again... sitting with the sublime, the uncomfortable and the love.

The Sky Cave will be different. I will be alone in a dark cave. I won't have a gong sounding for my meditation sits. I will have myself and the darkness. What will happen? I don't know. I know that I am called to go there and experience it. Maybe it is a call to fully love my Shadow. Maybe it is an invitation to let God in more fully. The darkness reminds me of a womb. I think that something is wanting to be born.

<u>June Mission: Kafika House</u>

On Sunday, June 1st, Ron and Ingrid Eggert introduced our mission of the month, Kafika House in northern Tanzania. Ron spoke from his experience of 9 years serving as the physician at a Lutheran teaching hospital. Children in the region suffered in disproportionate numbers from cleft palate, club foot, hydrocephalus, and devastating burns from cooking fires.

Volunteer surgeons came regularly to operate on up to 70 children in a 2-week period.

Then, after the surgeries, Ron and his colleagues were faced with the problem of what to do with children postoperatively. Most children came from single room homes with stick and mud walls and dirt floors – a non-hygienic environment for healing. Children were unable to leave the hospital until surgical wounds healed, but hospital beds were at a premium. A vision emerged and Kafika House (first known as Plaster House) was launched in 2008.

At Kafika House, children receive loving care until they are able to return home – for a week or up to several months. Prior to their surgeries, many of these children have been hidden away

due to their disabilities. Arriving at Kafika House marks the first time that they have unlimited nutritious food, playmates and peers, education, and the opportunity to truly embrace childhood.
